

JESUS LEAD LIKE JESUS



OUTLINE COURSE CONTENT

FATHER'S BUSINESS 01. VISION, RELATIONSHIPS AND BEHAVIOUR

Looking at Luke 2:49, develop a vision for how you are "about the Father's business"

TEMPTATION 02. SELF-TALK AND SELF-WORTH

Drawing from the temptation of Jesus in Luke 4:1-13 this unit explores the lies and the truths around identity and ability

PARABLES 03. STORYTELLING

Using the power and principles of parables as demonstrated by Jesus you will explore and communicate your most powerful story

APPRENTICESHIP 04. FOLLOW ME

Jesus was both apprenticed (Luke 2:51-52) and he apprenticed others (Luke 5:27). How as leaders will we both be apprenticed and apprentice others?

SERVANTHOOD 05. SERVANT LEADERSHIP

What does it mean to serve as Jesus did (Luke 22:24-27) within the context of leadership?

SABBATH REST 06. RHYTHMS OF REST & RENEWAL

Through an exploration of Sabbath Rest participants consider the necessity of and cultivate a plan for patterns of rest and renewal.

THE LORD NEEDS IT 07. KNOWING YOURSELF

To steward well what God has given you in terms of gifts, personality and ability requires first having a clear understanding of yourself.

COUNT THE COST 08. STRATEGY & INTENTION


This unit helps participants develop strategic planning skills which are invaluable in any leadership context.

WRITING IN THE SAND 09. CONFLICT MANAGEMENT

Through exploring John 8, Jesus' masterful conflict management skills are analysed and applied.

LEAD LIKE JESUS 10. LEADERSHIP PHILOSOPHY

What kind of person and leader are you called to be and how will you structure your life that this vision would be realised?





WHAT DO YOU NEED TO KNOW ADDITIONAL INFO

- The course requires a 12 month commitment. It will be run over a series of 10 sessions (in person) scheduled over the space 12 months
- The sessions while including a formal teaching component will be heavily weighted towards discussion and interaction.
- The course will focus on the leadership life of Jesus and will also include materials sourced from the Harvard Business Review and the Oxford Executive Leadership Program.
- While there is no formal financial commitment, there will be some incidental costs during the course content.
- The course will run one Saturday morning a month, beginning in February 2024.

APPLICATION PROCESS.

Inclusion into the Lead Like Jesus program is based on an application process. Due to the nature of the program this process exists to help determine the suitability of a person in terms of their capacities and goals. The application process helps assess whether the course will truly be benefical for the person applying.
